

Ballet/Tap Class Info

Thought I'd send a quick note with some helpful info about our Ballet/Tap class and what your dancer will need before their first day. It can take a little time to find the right items, so I wanted to make sure you're set up for success. 😊

- Where to shop: Walmart and Target often carry ballet and tap shoes, and The Dance Store in Salem is a wonderful resource if you want to try things on. Amazon is also a great option for online shopping.
- For class:
 - Tap shoes: Black tap shoes (for both boys and girls).
 - Ballet shoes: Pink ballet slippers for girls, black ballet slippers for boys.
 - Dancewear: Pink tights and any color leotard for girls (graphics and attached skirts are welcome). Boys should wear dark sweats or long shorts with a comfy t-shirt.
- Class routine: We start with tap, so have your dancer wear their tap shoes when they come into class. Please write their name inside each shoe—trust me, it's a lifesaver!
- Shoe bag: Make sure your dancer brings a small bag to hold their shoes. When we switch from tap to ballet, it's so much easier to keep track of everyone's shoes if they're neatly swapped and stored.
